IMPACT 2022

Launching a charitable organisation with a mission to empower marginalised communities in Canada and around the world was a key highlight of 2022, marked by a significant commitment of \$2MM+ to support underrepresented communities in Canada, starting with a donation of \$300,000 over three years to the Century Initiative and \$250,000 for this year to the Tamil Community Centre.

The Foundation supported 4-hospitals - with each receiving \$10K - in the GTA & Durham Region with a dollar-for dollar matching donation strategy raised via the TCS Toronto Waterfront Marathon. And, we added \$15K to the Bursary program at my alma mater, St. Paul's High School in Winnipeg, MB.

We will continue to deepen the transformational and transgenerational impacts on society by prioritising the many pillars of wellness, often overlooked when thinking about the experiences of Black, Indigenous, and People of Colour in Canada and vulnerable populations abroad.

The Srinarayanathas Foundation committed to a \$1MM donation for the Tamil Community Centre, starting with a contribution of \$250K this year. While the GTA has a population of 122,000 Tamils, the Community Centre could potentially serve between 500-900 Tamil households in the Scarborough area (2016 Census), 236-500 Tamil households in the Durham area, and 750-1961 Tamil individuals in the South Markham area (according to 2019 Census data).

Team Srinarayanathas ran in the Toronto Waterfront Marathon to raise awareness for hospitals in the GTA & Durham regions including Lakeridge Health, Scarborough Health Network, Markham Stouffville Hospital and Holland Bloorivew Kids Rehabilitation Hospital.

Not only did we successfully reach our goal, the Foundation also matched \$20K, resulting in a donation total of \$40K for the hospitals.


